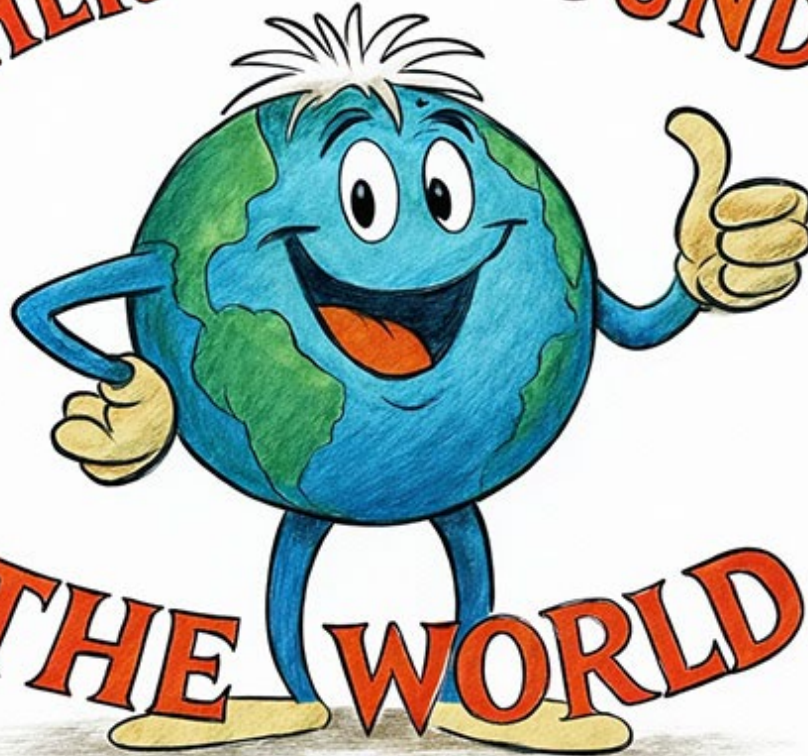
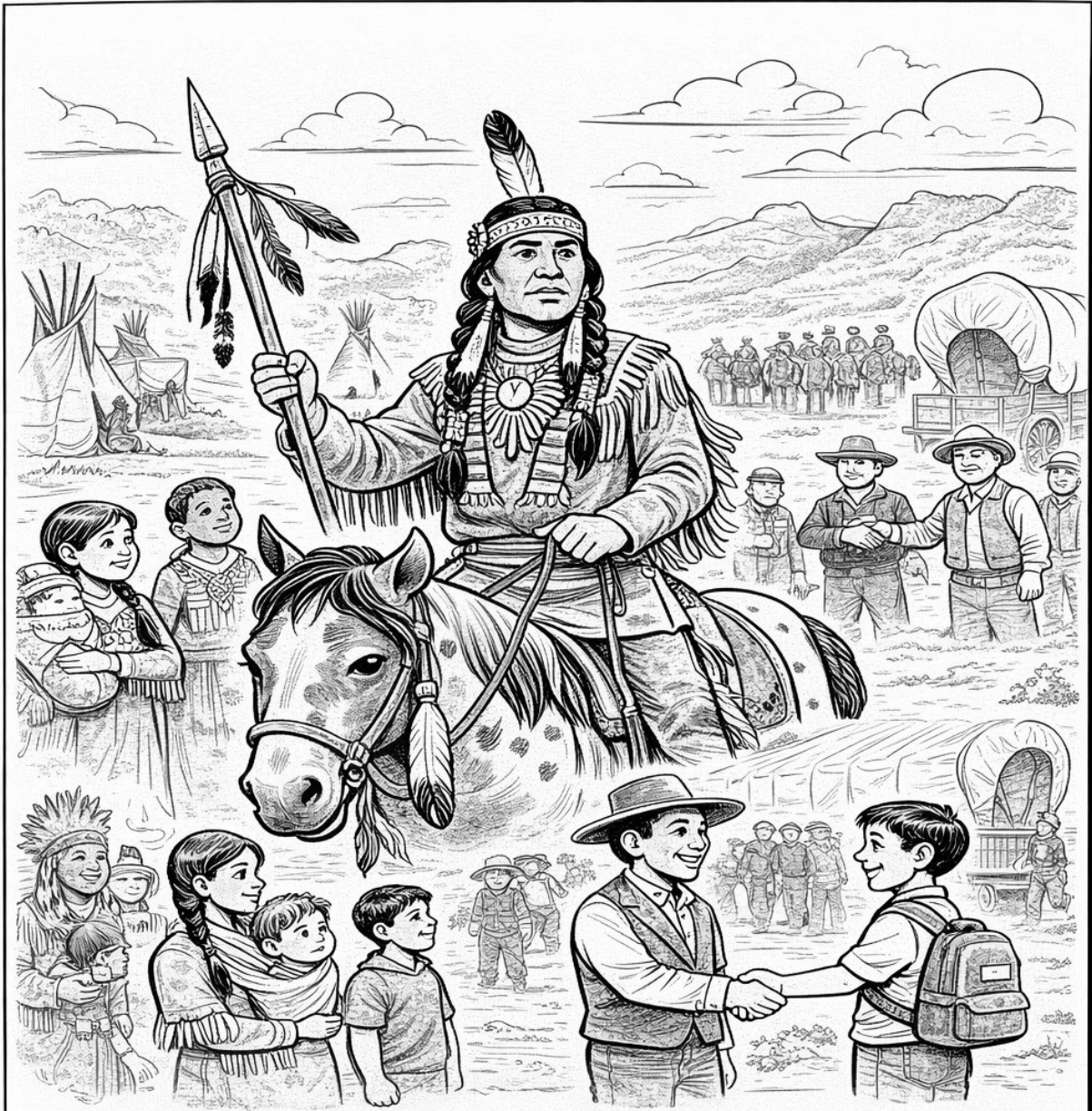

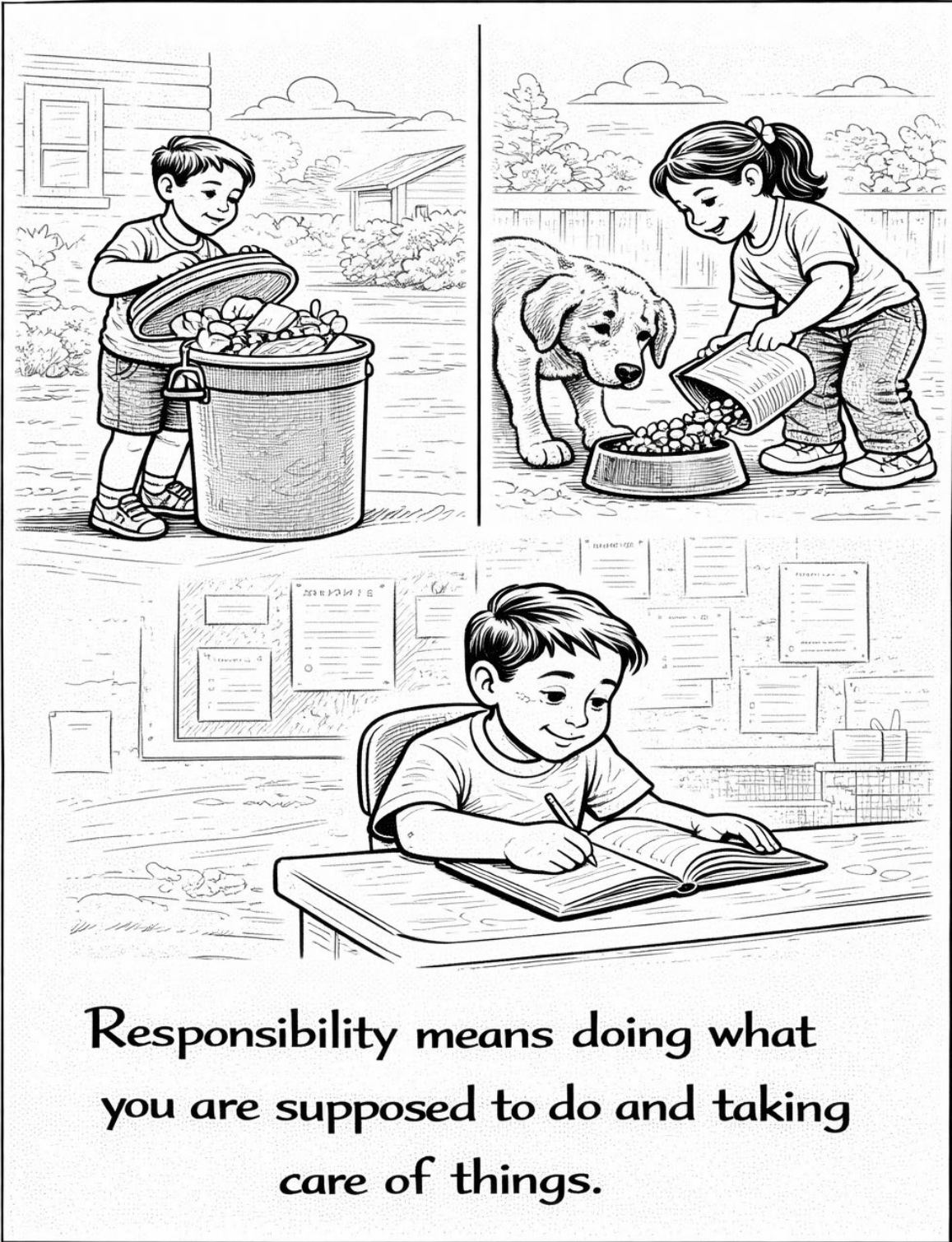


THE WORLD

Responsibility means doing what you are supposed to do and taking care of things.





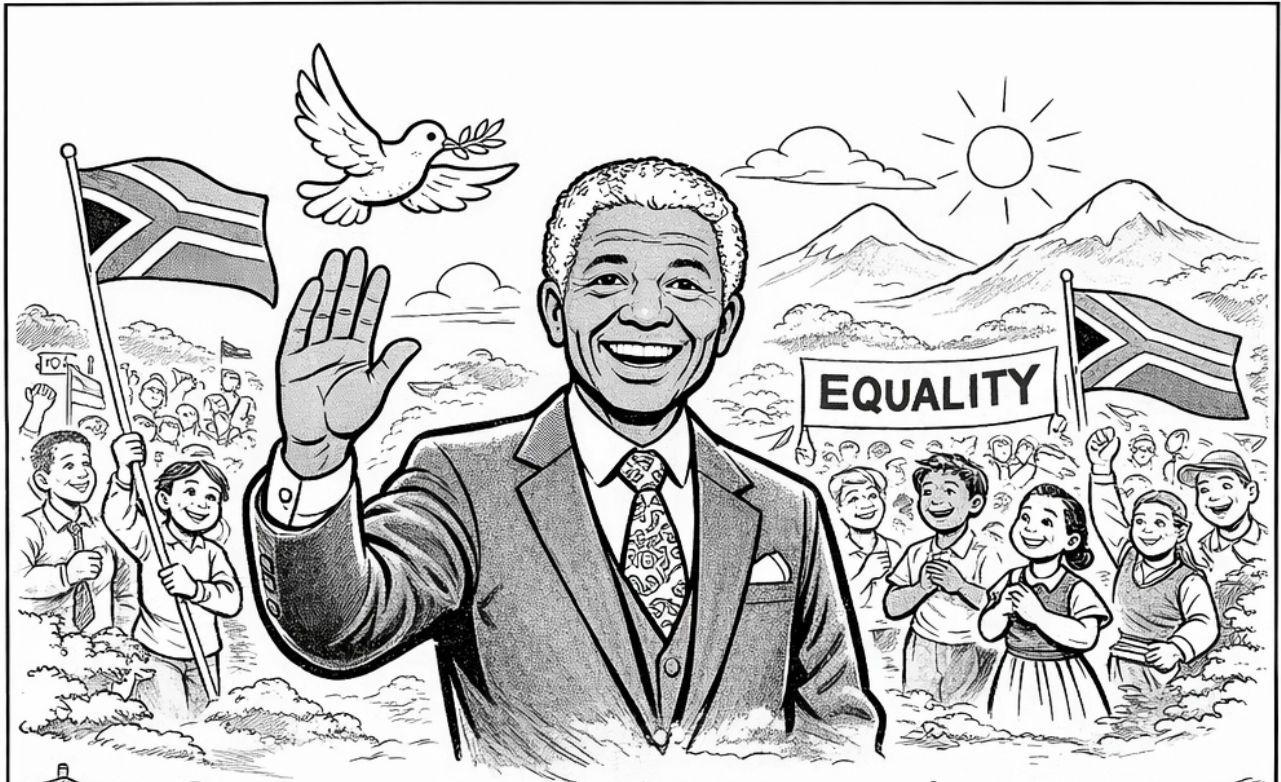
Confucius showed good citizenship.

You can show good citizenship by being kind, following the rules, and helping others when they need it. You might pick up trash, share with classmates, or include someone who feels left out.



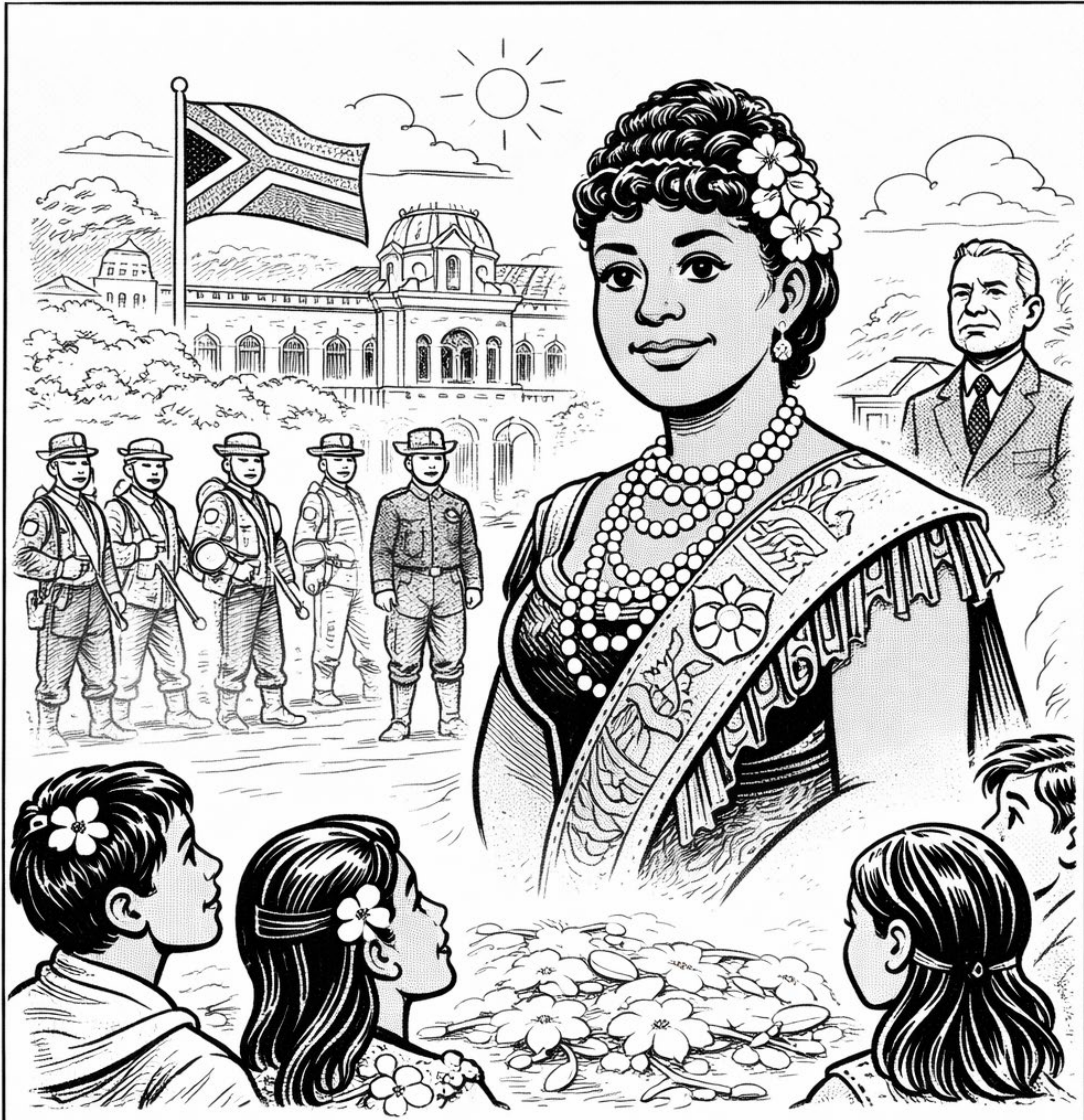
Nelson Mandela taught people to be fair. He worked to change unfair laws in South Africa so everyone would be treated the same.



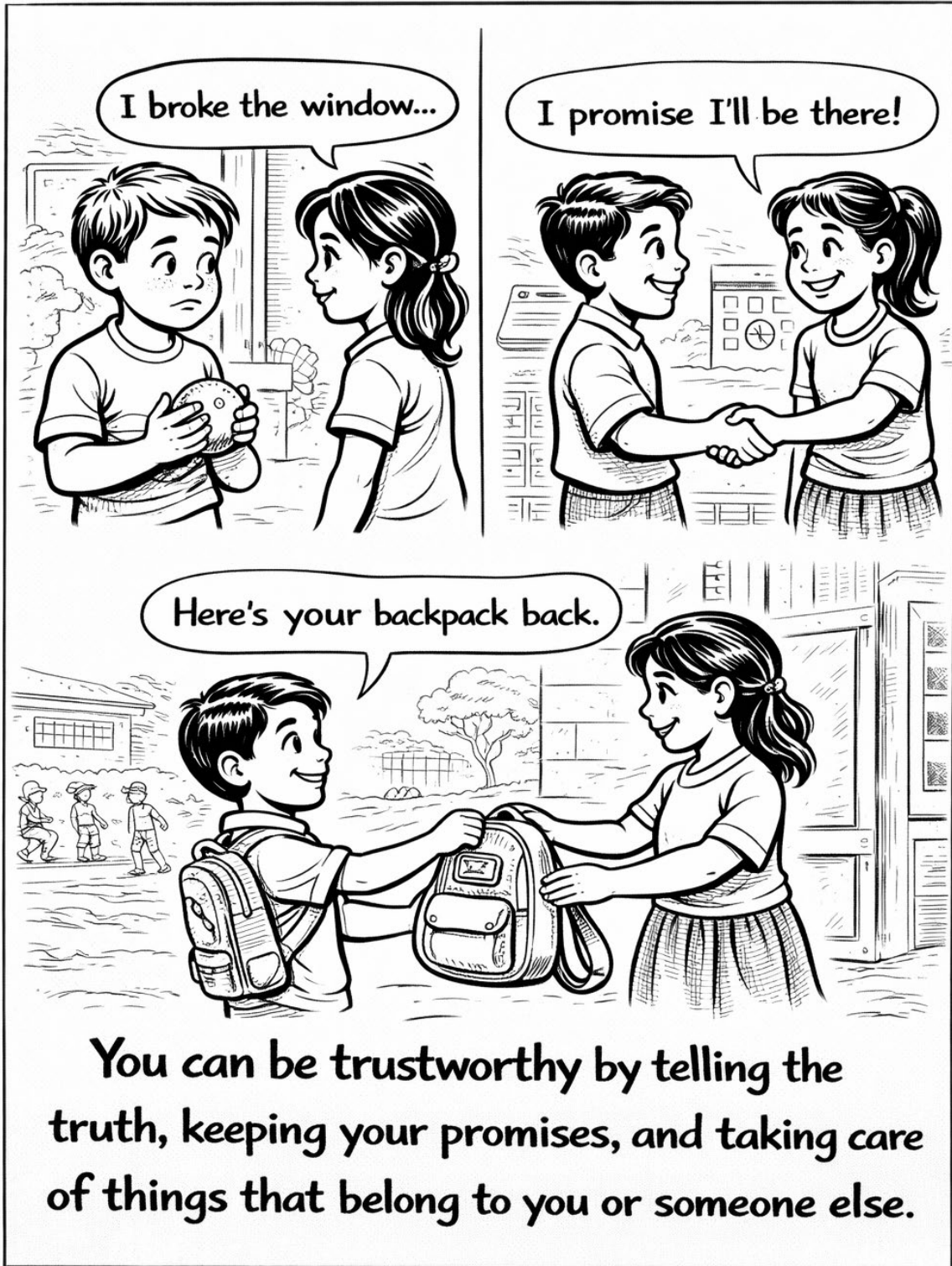
Being fair means treating people the way you would want to be treated. You can be fair by taking turns, sharing, and listening to everyone's ideas.

so everyone has the same chance to win.**

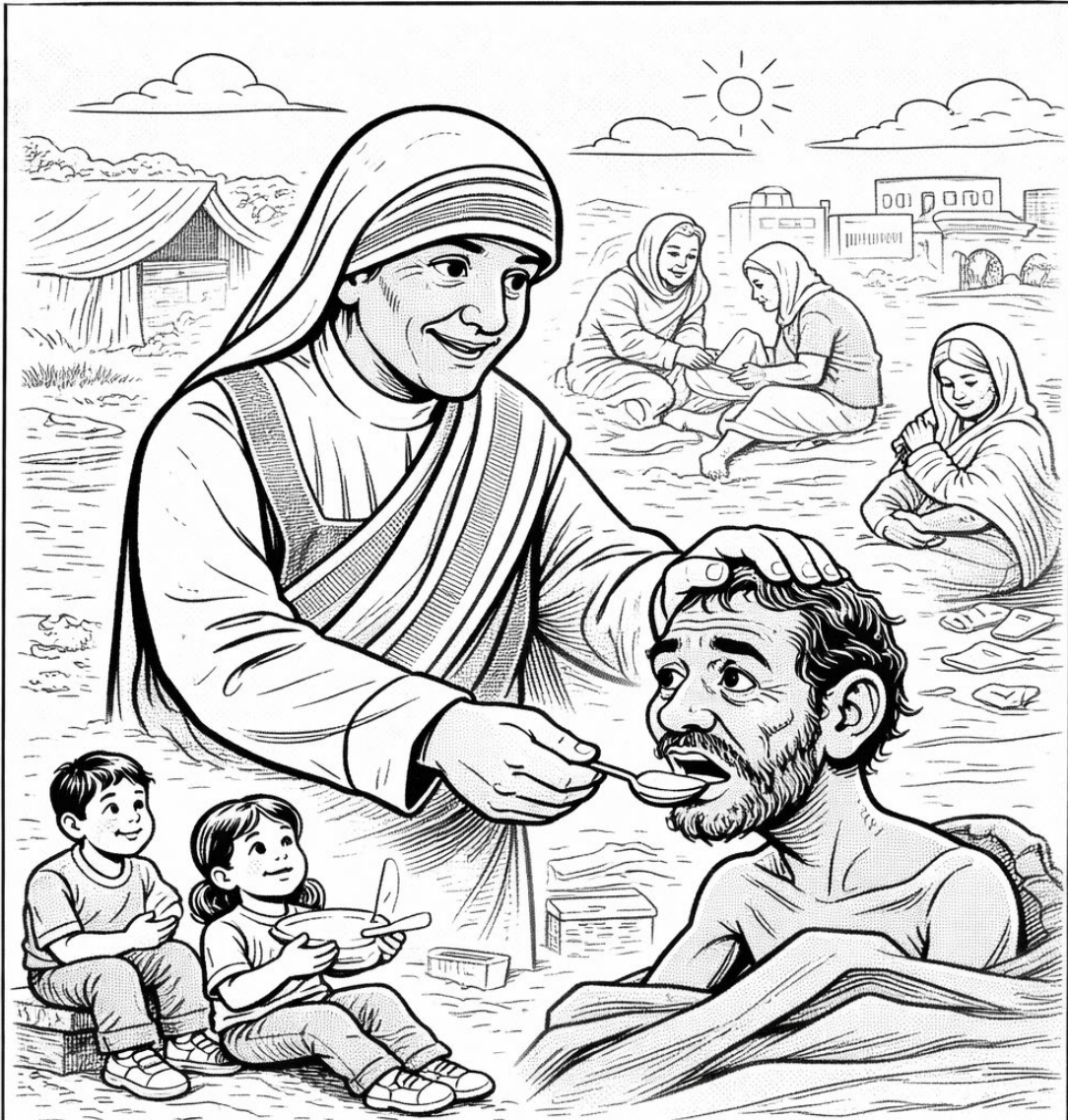

people learn they can trust you.**

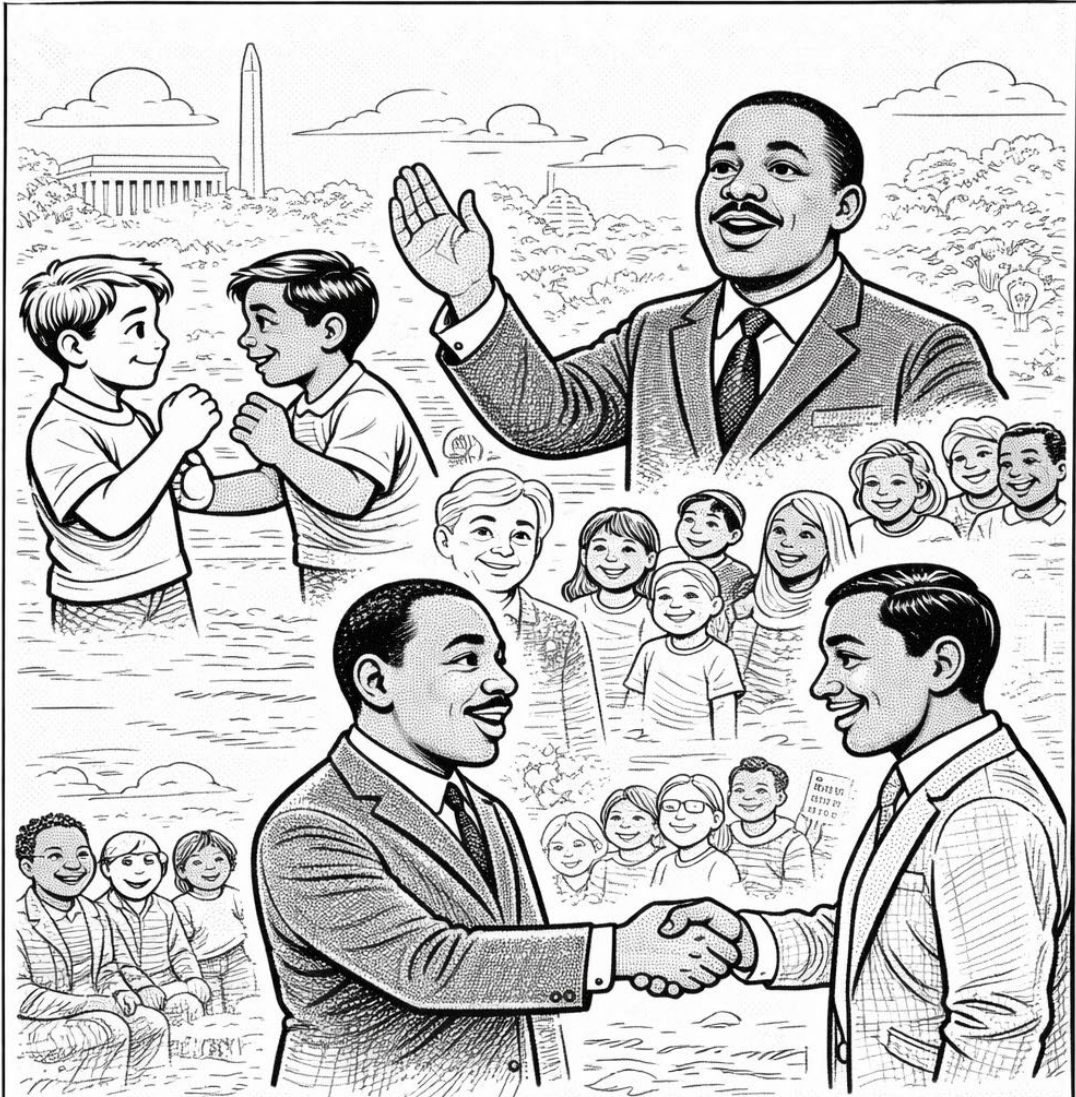


Mother Teresa showed people what it means to be caring. She spent her life helping poor and sick people and teaching that everyone deserves kindness.

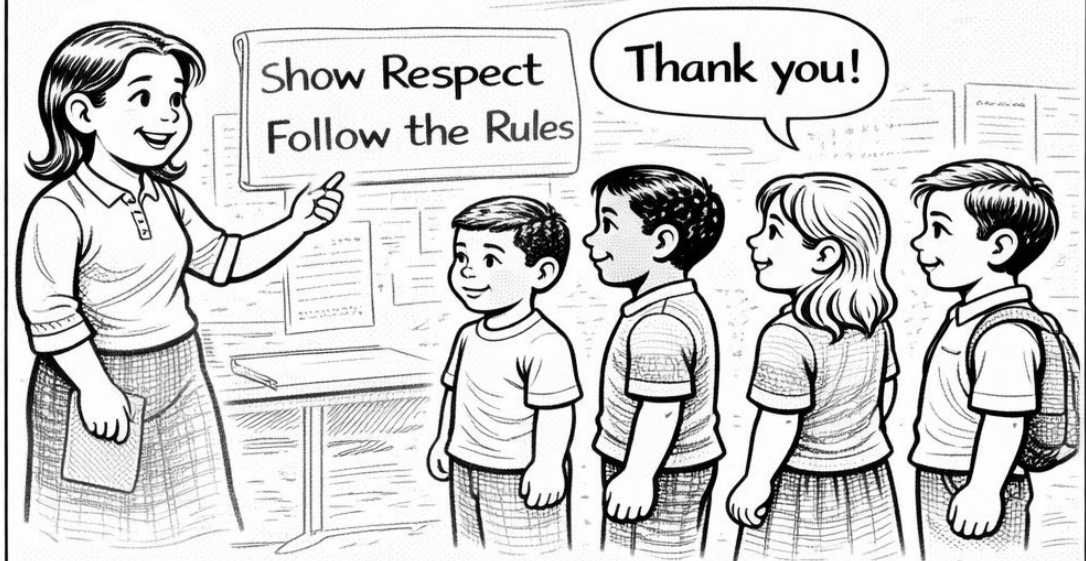




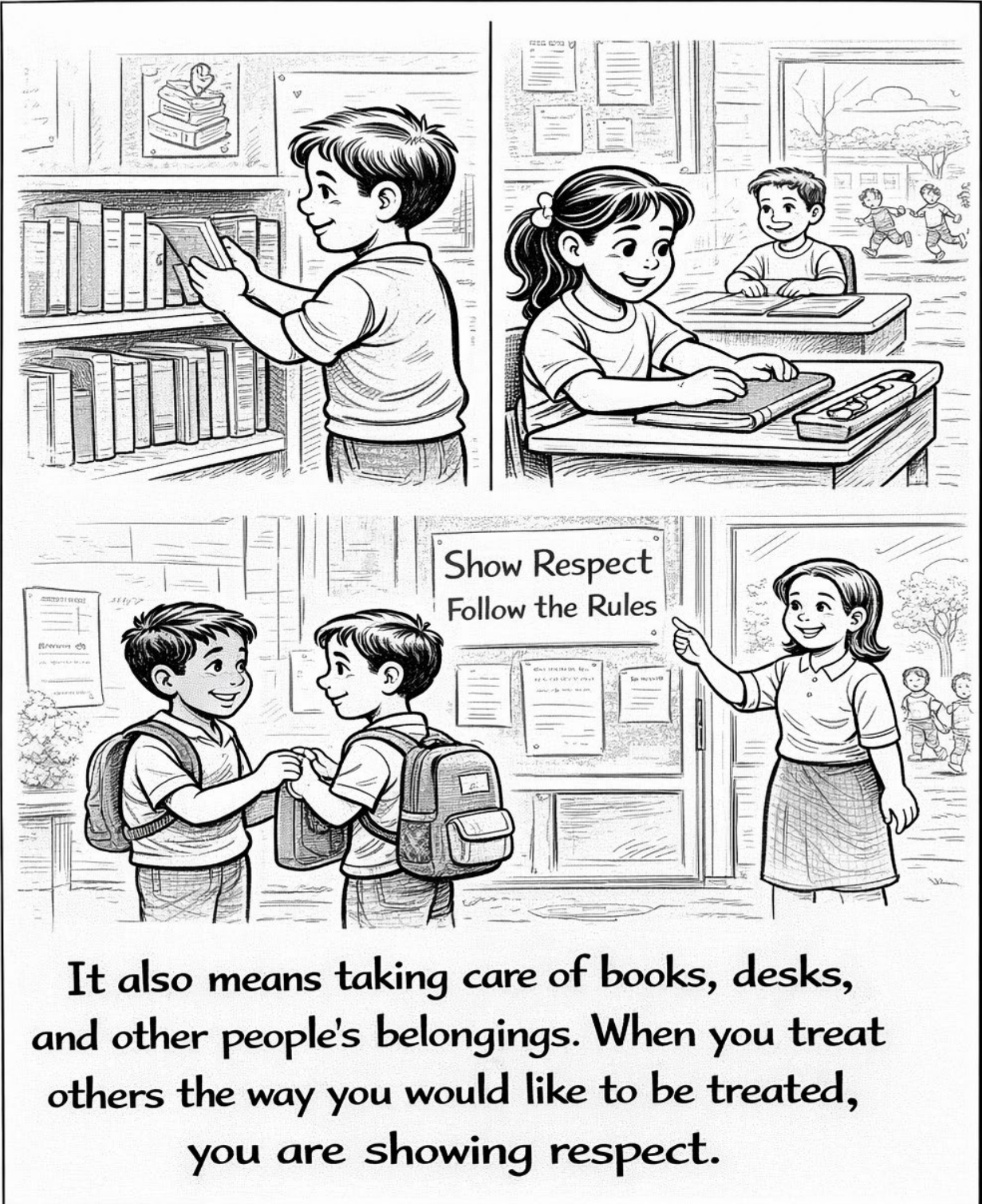
**When you try to make others
